Fundamentals of Health & Safety in the work place



Who is this qualification aimed at?

This Award is designed to create a better understanding of Health & Safety. It emphasizes safety for himself/herself, safety for others and is capable of identifying potential hazards. Most accidents are attributable to a lack of knowledge or carelessness and this award focuses on increasing awareness as a key improvement

What does it cover?

- *Importance of Health & Safety*
- *personnel and Systems*
- *Requirements and enforcement of legislation*
- *Identification of hazards and their possible effects*
- *Methods of creating a safe working environment*
- *Methods of dealing with accidents*

Courses usually involve 9 guided learning hours. Attainment of the learning outcome is assessed by examination. The examination is in two parts: a multiple choice test and a hazard spotting exercise. Both parts of the assessment must be passed in order for a candidate to be awarded the certificate.

Entry requirements

There are no recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. The recommendation is that candidates have a level of literacy equivalent to Entry Level 2.
