Level 1 Award in Hazard Awareness



Who is this qualification aimed at?

This award is relevant to workers in all general work settings. It is particularly suitable for young people who would like to increase their ability to identify and understand "Hazards" in preparation for work experience and beginning employment. The award provides a starting point from which to progress to more specific risk awareness knowledge, leading to lifelong learning in Health & Safety knowledge Unit 'HSK1' (Basic Hazard Awareness) as published by the Standards Setting Body 'ENTO'

What does it cover?

- *General Introduction to Health & Safety*
- *Hazards & Accidents*
- *The working Environment*
- *Welfare Provision*
- *Personal Protective Equipment*

The recommended number of guided learning hours is 4 and the assessment consist of one 45 minute examination paper of 20 multiple choice questions. Successful candidates are awarded either a 'Pass' or 'Credit' and receive a RSPH certificate.

Entry requirements

Prior to taking the examination, candidates must attain the knowledge outcomes.
